I lectured on September 06: *On the radius of convergence of an entire function in a normed space*. |

I chaired the morning session of September 05. The first speaker was Pierre Lelong, 09:00–10:00. He lectured in French. |

### 1967, Paris

Let us jump back a little. On 1967 December 04, Józef was invited by Pierre Lelong to talk at his *Séminaire*. His title was *Separately analytic functions and envelopes of holomorphy of some lower dimensional subsets of  $\mathbb{C}^n$*  (LNM 71, 1968). |

We did not meet there; I gave a talk later, on 1968 March 13.

### 1971, Paris

On 1971 February 24 and March 03, Józef was invited again to talk at *Séminaire Lelong*. His title was *A polynomial lemma and analytic mappings in topological vector spaces* (LNM 275, 1972).

### 1976, Uppsala

Józef Siciak was invited as a guest professor to Uppsala University during six weeks.

### 1976, Kraków, Łódź

In 1976 I went to Gdańsk by ship and then flew to Kraków on September 14. |

Lecture at the meeting of the Polish Math Society in Kraków September 20:  *$\delta$ -plurisubharmonic functions*, announced as *Funkcje  $\delta$ -plursubharmoniczne*. The venue was UJ, Reymonta 4. |

To Łódź September 20, invited by Julian Ławrynowicz. A short visit to Kielce and a lecture there. |

Left Poland on September 28.

### 1977, Paris

Józef was a guest professor at Paris VI for two months in the spring.

### 1978, Helsinki

Both Józef and I participated in the International Congress of Mathematicians (ICM) in Helsinki, August 15–23.

The participants from Poland came in a ship and slept in the harbor of Helsinki, a very practical arrangement . . .

I came with my car from Uppsala with Urban Cegrell (my doctor #2, 1975) and Aboubakr Bayoumi (then a PhD student; my doctor #4, 1979).

### 1978, Joensuu

After the big congress in Helsinki, Ilpo Laine invited us to Joensuu for the *Colloquium on Complex Analysis*, August 24–27. |

Józef's talk, on August 24, had the title *On holomorphic extendability of functions on generic real analytic submanifolds*. |

My talk, on August 26, had the title *On the density of plurisubharmonic functions: a short proof of Siu's theorem*. |

As mentioned, I came by car from Uppsala. I could drive also Józef to Joensuu, but he went back to Helsinki by train.

### 1978, Uppsala

Józef was invited to Uppsala University for about two weeks in November.

He lectured on *Approximation of rational functions with a fixed finite set of poles*.

### 1979, Kozubnik, Warsaw

Lecture: *Growth of plurisubharmonic functions*. |

To Warsaw April 26: *Semester on Complex Analysis*, Banach Center, April 26 — May 09. |

Józef's talk had the title *On the equivalence between locally polar and globally polar sets in  $\mathbb{C}^n$* . |

I talked on *The use of conjugate convex functions in complex analysis*.

## 1982, Tokyo

## 1983, Toulouse

In Toulouse May 24–27, there was a conference with 77 participants and 22 lectures. |

Józef talked on *Highly noncontinuable functions on polynomially convex sets*. |

My title was: *Sur la définition de l'opérateur de Monge–Ampère complexe*.

Józef talked about *An extension of Abel's lemma to the n-dimensional case with examples of applications.* |

My title was *Asymptotic approximation of plurisubharmonic functions in pseudoconvex domains.*

In the spring, Józef was invited as a visitor to the program of several complex variables at Institut Mittag-Leffler by John Erik Fornaess and me.
